Limited Issues

These pins were issued in very limited quantities and are being documented mainly to protect the integrity of Virginia pins. They are NOT considered to be trading pins and most collectors may NOT be able to obtain them.

Lions of Virginia Script Pins
Each District Governor is limited to 10 each year to present to Lions in their District who have exceeded far beyond what was expected of them.



NOTE: The 2008 Script pin was remade to correct defects. All of the defect pins were recovered, except for the 10 in 24-C. These pins have two clasps on the reverse and the new ones have only one clasp. Also, the lettering on the ones retained in 24-C are not clearly cutout.

MULTIPLE DISTRICT 24 - Limited Issues

These pins were issued in very limited quantities and are being documented mainly to protect the integrity of Virginia pins. They are NOT considered to be trading pins and most collectors may NOT be able to obtain them.

Lions of Virginia Script Pins
Each District Governor is limited to 10 each year to present to Lions in their District who have exceeded far beyond what was expected of them.

Secretary Awards

These Secretary Awards have become so collectible and are in the collections of a good many collectors. Consequently, we have agreed to show them to not only document all of our pins, but to hopefully clarify the original purpose/intent of these issues. An example of the misunderstanding that can arise from issues such as these can be found in the Color Catalog of MD Pins that was issued several years ago by Lion Joe Trezza of California. That Catalog incorrectly shows the 1961 award (copper) as the 1961 State pin. There was no State pin issued in 1961. These awards were discontinued after the 1963 issue, at the request of LCI.

The District Governor in each respective District presented a set of gold cuff links to each member of his Cabinet. Because of the total number of cabinet members throughout the State, these cuff links have become highly collectible, particularly since they are identical to the 1962 pin for that year. We show them here merely to document the fact that they exist and may, from time-to-time, show up in pin auctions. They obviously are NOT trading pins.

These pins were issued by the Council of Governors in limited quantities, for the most part, to commemorate their year or to raise funds for a specific Lions charitable activity.






